

## **Voting Eligibility at the online Baptist Assembly 2021**

### **For the resolutions to re-affirm the Treasurer and Moderator of the Board of Trustees:**

All Members of the Assembly are eligible to vote on these resolutions. This includes:

#### *Churches*

All churches in membership of BUGB are able to send representatives to vote on these resolutions at Assembly, with the number of representatives/votes from each church being determined by the number of members:

- Churches with between 1 and 99 members have one vote.
- Churches with between 100 and 199 members have two votes.
- Churches with 200 or more members have three votes.

#### *Ministers*

Ministers on the BUGB Register of Nationally Accredited Ministers in categories 1, 2, 3 and 4 can vote on these resolutions.

Additionally, if you have been appointed as the Minister, Assistant Minister or Minister in Training of a church in membership with BUGB, even if you are not on the Accredited Register, or are on the Accredited Register in category 5, then you are eligible to vote on these resolutions.

Retired Ministers (who are in category 5 of the Accredited Register) are also able to vote on these resolutions.

#### *Other Categories*

Other people able to vote on these resolutions at Assembly include:

- Members of BUGB Council
- Two representatives from each College in membership with BUGB
- Two representatives from each Association in membership with BUGB
- Personal Members of the Union (accepted before 2007)

### **For the resolution regarding the unincorporated Baptist Union charity**

Only Members of the Baptist Union may vote on this resolution:

#### *Churches*

All churches who were in membership of BUGB prior to the adoption of the CIO constitution in 2020 are able to send representatives to vote on this resolution at Assembly, with the number of representatives/votes from each church being determined by the number of members:

- Churches with between 1 and 99 members have one vote.
- Churches with between 100 and 199 members have two votes.
- Churches with 200 or more members have three votes.

#### *Other Categories*

Other people able to vote on this resolution at Assembly include:

- Two representatives from each College in membership with BUGB
- Two representatives from each Association in membership with BUGB
- Personal Members of the Union (accepted before 2007)
