CHARITY FRAUD AWARENESS WEEK

Charity Fraud Awareness Week runs from 18 - 22 October 2021. The purpose of the week is to raise awareness of fraud and cybercrime that affects the charity sector and to create a space for charities to talk about fraud and share good practice.

PRESCHOOLS – NEW STATUTORY FRAMEWORK

Earlier this year the Department for Education published a new Statutory Framework for the early years foundation stage. This framework is mandatory for all early years providers in England from 1 September 2021. The changes to the framework include longer, more in-depth examples of activities in the educational programme section and the safeguarding and welfare section now contains a new requirement to promote the good oral health of children. Early learning goals have also changed to be more specific and summarise the skills and understanding all young children should have by the time they turn five.

There is also new non-statutory curriculum guidance called Development Matters that can be used from 1 September 2021 to assist in putting educational programmes into practice.

Any churches operating preschools should note these changes and adapt their curriculum around the new educational programmes. Further information can be found <u>here</u>
